GUNDERSON FAMILY DAIRY - SHANNON, IL 2 LELY A5 ROBOTS - HERD AVERAGE CONSISTENTLY OVER 100 POUNDS OF MILK A DAY



BRIEF HISTORY:

In 2010, Rob and Kelli Gunderson started farming independently with a 58-tie-stall pipeline barn and a 99-stall freestall barn. In 2014, they purchased 5-acres and began building a 100- x 264-foot bedded pack barn. Over the next few years, they continued to expand their dairy with the largest expansion occurring in the summers of 2017 and 2018 where they installed 230 freestalls and added a robot room and milk house. In February of 2019, they installed two Lely A5 robots which allowed for 120 of their cows to be transitioned from the tie-stall barn to the new facility. Gundersons still milk 70 cows in the tie-stall barn but their end goal is to purchase two more robots and fully transition to the new facility.

INTERVIEW WITH THE GUNDERSONS:

Largest benefit with having two Lely A5s:

- Ability to spend more time on herd health rather than milking. The rumination collars help Rob and his employees identify sick cows sooner, which helps achieve the cows feeling better faster.
- Increase in milk production! The Gundersons feel the robots offer a huge advantage in getting fresh cows off to a good start. They have numerous fresh cows being milked four to five times a day, producing more than 150 pounds a day at 30 days in milk.
- The A5s have given Rob more flexibility to spend time with his family. Rob is able to go to more of his kids' sporting events and other activities that often take place in the afternoons, evenings and weekends. This past fall, he was even able to coach his son's flag football team.

Experience with transitioning their barn over to robots:

• The Gundersons felt transitioning their barn over to A5s was very smooth. The cows adjusted to the robots quickly, and are comfortable and content in the barn.

ROBOT RETROFIT

THOMPSON FAMILY FARM - BARNEVELD, WI RETROFIT BARN

Are you interested in "modernizing" your barn but rebuilding isn't an option? Have you heard of "retrofitting?" Retrofitting your barn involves taking your existing barn and restructuring it to accommodate robots. Contrary to popular belief, you can make robots work in an existing freestall barn. If fact, you can retrofit almost all sizes of operations.

How you ask? Well, we design your barn with the cows in mind. Retrofit barns are all about cow flow and creating a calm, stress-free environment to improve cow health and well-being to result in better producing cows. You want your barn to be free of obstacles so your cows can easily visit the robot throughout the day. With our customer, Kyle Thompson, we did just this. We took their existing stanchion barn and transformed it into a single robot retrofit barn. We designed their layout for optimal cow traffic to the robot. We incorporated a comfortable distance to and from the robot making the milking process enjoyable for cows, added hoof baths, feed, and water stations, and designed the barn with sufficient ventilation and easy access to the robot room.

HERE IS WHAT KYLE HAD TO SAY ABOUT THEIR RETROFIT BARN:

The main benefit we have seen is flexibility. Flexibility in when we start and end our day, flexibility with fieldwork, and flexibility in our daily life. We are able to start our day an hour later and end an hour earlier, we are able to decide when we want to do chores, and we are able to spend more time with our family.

The most challenging part of the process was figuring out what we wanted to do and what we could make work. With Argall Dairy Systems help, we looked at a lot of different set-ups to determine what would work best on our farm.





WAIKATO ROTARY GOAT PARLOR Laughing goat dairy - Cuba City, Wi



In 2019, Jean Rossard, former owner of Montchevre Cheese Plant in Belmont, Wisconsin, and his two sons, Simon and Julian, started Laughing Goat Dairy in Cuba City, Wisconsin.

This 60-stall rotary, installed by Argall Dairy Systems, is the first goat rotary of this particular equipment in the United States and the second in North America. Currently milking 400 goats, the Rossards plan to eventually milk over 1,000 goats.

The rotary parlor contains Waikato milking equipment: Centrus stalls with a composite deck, NaviGate Dairy Management System, auto feeding, milk yield sensors, presentation arm, and an operator console display.

Scott Argall, owner of Argall Dairy Systems, traveled to Canada with Waikato and Rossard to see the equipment in action prior to installation.




